

Dear Flywell members,

Our first priority at Flywell has always been the safety of our members. Given concerns about the evolving Coronavirus global pandemic and our shared responsibility to limit spread, can I ask that everyone follow a few courtesies, practices and precautions regarding use of Flywell aircraft and common club facilities to keep everyone safe?

The CDC has provided [interim guidance for community groups](#) like ours to stay safe in the face of this Coronavirus disease.

Limit exposure: If you're feeling sick or suspect that you've been exposed to someone with the Coronavirus, please refrain from using Flywell aircraft and avoid coming to the hanger until the risk of transmission is passed. If you must come to the hangar during time of potential exposure, please use a face mask and limit your time. For those of our members in the higher risk population, please take extra care to avoid exposure. Please confidentially notify me or another board member if you have tested positive or could have been exposed to someone with Covid19.

Prevention and cleaning: A container of disinfectant wipes will be placed in the boardroom for use by members. Please use the disinfectant wipes to clean any and all common surfaces:

- When returning an aircraft, please wipe down and disinfect aircraft surfaces normally touched with your hands on or in the airplane, e.g. yoke, knobs, seats, door handle, oil dipstick. Take care to only use a damp cloth on the electronics to avoid fluid seeping into the electronics.
- After using the office please wipe down the area where you worked, e.g. table, handles of doors, microwave, iPads, etc.
- When using the bathroom please wipe down the toilet and counter.
- Remember to wash your hands often.

Social Distance: The CDC suggests limiting extended face-to-face contact by replacing in-person meetings with tele- or video-conferences. So, until further notice, Flywell board and membership meetings will be made available to the members by remote attendance (e.g. Skype). Expect communication soon on how to participate in the April board meeting.

Finally, go flying. It's the most fun kind of social distancing; just remember practice minimum separation per FAR 91.119.

We will provide updates as the situation develops. Thank you for your cooperation. Together we can stay safe, and continue to enjoy our Flywell community.
